## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR BIBLE**

The Alpha Omega Curriculum from grades two through twelve was written with the daily instructional material written directly in the LIFEPACs. The student is encouraged to read and follow his own instructional material thus developing independent study habits. The teacher should introduce the LIFEPAC to the student, set a required completion schedule, complete teacher checks, be available for questions regarding both subject content and procedures, administer and grade tests and develop additional learning activities as desired. Teachers working with several students may schedule their time so that students are assigned to a quiet work activity when it is necessary to spend instructional time with one particular student.

The Teacher Notes section of the handbook lists the required or suggested materials for the LIFEPACs and provides additional learning activities for the students. The materials section refers only to LIFEPAC materials and does not include materials which may be needed for the additional activities. Additional learning activities provide a change from the daily school routine, encourage the student's interest in learning and may be used as a reward for good study habits.

**Additional Learning Activities**

**Section I. *God Our Father***

1. Discuss these questions with your class.
  - a. Who put the love in parents' hearts that they have for their children?
  - b. Does God love you as much as your parents love you?
  - c. Does God love you more than your parents can love you?
  - d. Why can your parents not love you as much as God loves you?
  - e. Do you feel safe in God's love?
  - f. What was the best way God showed His love for you?
2. Create a little drama. A number of children act like naughty or disagreeable children. Two children play the parts of parents who come in and show how loving parents deal with problems and discipline their children. All of the children discuss their ideas.
3. Draw pictures of things you can do to show kindness to someone else.
4. Make up a prayer of your own and write it in your best handwriting. Decorate the border. Paste it on heavier colored paper and hang it in your bedroom.

**Section II. *The Word of God***

1. Review these Bible stories with your class.
  - a. Daniel trusting God
  - b. Moses, the leader
  - c. David and Goliath
  - d. Paul, the missionary
  - e. the Creation
2. Make a mural of many of the things God created.
3. Write the psalm you wrote for Activity 2.16 (or another psalm) in your best handwriting. Decorate the border. Paste the psalm on colored construction paper, Perhaps you can hang it in the schoolroom or perhaps you will want to give it to your parents or a friend.
4. Make up a tune for the psalm you wrote (Activity 2.16). Sing it for the class or for your parents. Play it on the piano or another musical instrument if you can.

**Section III. *Life With God***

1. Review with the class the events in the lives of these people:
  - a. Joseph,
  - b. Abraham, and
  - c. Jesus.
2. Divide the class into two groups. The members of one group take turns saying something Jesus did. The members of the other group take turns saying whether or not we can do a similar thing.
